RESOLUTION AND ORDER OF ELECTION BOARD OF TRUSTEES NAVARRO COLLEGE DISTRICT

WHEREAS, pursuant to state law, the Board of Trustees adopted a single member district plan which provides for four single member districts and three at-large districts: and

WHEREAS, a Board member from Single Member District 2 is to be elected in 2025, to serve a term of six (6) years or until their successor has been duly elected and qualified pursuant to the provisions of the Texas Education Code and Texas Election Code; and

WHEREAS, a Board member from Single Member District 3 is to be elected in 2025, to serve a term of six (6) years or until their successor has been duly elected and qualified pursuant to the provisions of the Texas Education Code and Texas Election Code; and

WHEREAS, a Board member from District At-Large 5 is to be elected in 2025, to serve a term of six (6) years until their successor has been duly elected and qualified pursuant to the provisions of the Texas Education Code and the Texas Election Code.

BE IT, ORDERED AND HEREBY RESOLVED, that the Board of Trustees of the Navarro College District, in accordance with the local and special laws of the Legislature of the State of Texas, the applicable general state laws and local policies and any federal court orders pertaining to the election of college trustees, does hereby adopt the following ORDER OF ELECTION.

ORDER OF ELECTION

BE IT ORDERED by the Board of Trustees of the Navarro College District that on May 3, 2025, there shall be a general election for the purpose of electing three (3) members to the Board of Trustees. One member shall be elected from Single Member District Two (2) as Board Member Place 1 to serve a six (6) year term, or until a successor has been duly elected and qualified. One member shall be elected from Single Member District Three (3) as Board Member Place 1 to serve a six (6) year term, or until a successor has been duly elected and qualified. One member shall be elected from District At-Large Five (5) as Board Member Place 7 to serve a six (6) year term, or until a successor has been duly elected and qualified; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED that the member to be elected from Single Member District Two shall be elected by the qualified voters of Navarro County Commissioner Precinct Two, which comprises Single Member District Two. The member to be elected from Single Member District Three shall be elected by the qualified voters of Navarro County Commissioner Precinct Two, which comprises Single Member District Three. The member to be elected Board Trustee District At-Large Place Five shall be elected at large by the qualified voters of Navarro County; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED that all candidates seeking election as a board member must reside within the single member district for the single member district position, they seek and all candidates seeking election as an at-large member of the Board of Trustees must reside within the boundaries of Navarro County Texas. Pursuant to state law, each candidate must reside in the specific single-member district or in the case

of the at-large position in the county for six (6) months preceding the final day to file for such office, the final day to file is February 14, 2025; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED that every candidate must designate that he or she is a candidate for a specific single member district or the specific at large positions, on his or her application to become a candidate. Such application shall be filed with the Secretary of the Board, through the designee, Teresa Thomas, CPA, Vice President of Finance, not later than 5:00 p.m. on the 14th day of February 2025; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED that on the first Saturday in May 2025, being the 3rd day of May 2025, the election shall be held from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. on said day. If no candidate receives a majority of the votes cast for the office for which he or she is a candidate, a runoff election shall be held. Only the names of the two candidates who received the highest number of votes for the office for which a runoff is required shall be placed on the ballot for such runoff election: and

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED that Allie Thomas, Navarro County Elections

Administrator, whose mailing address is Post Office Box 1018, Corsicana, Texas 75151
1018, is hereby appointed Clerk for Early Voting. Early voting for the election of college board members shall be held at the Navarro County Annex, 601 N. 13th Street, Suite 3, Corsicana, Texas 75110; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED that the early voting shall be held from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. on each day for early voting which is not a Saturday, Sunday or an official state holiday, beginning on April 21, 2025, and continuing through April 29, 2025, for early voting by personal appearance; and

BE IT, FURTHER RESOLVED, AND ORDERED that the Board of Trustees of the Navarro College District, in accordance with the local policy, and special and general laws of the Legislature of the State of Texas pertaining to the election of college board members, do hereby select those polling locations identified on <u>Attachment "A"</u>. Each polling site is located within the county and will serve as the polling place for those voters in the Navarro County election precinct(s) which are assigned to each polling place listed for the May 3, 2025, Navarro College District Board of Trustees election.
